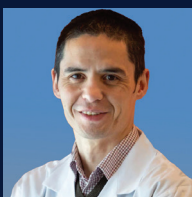

Dr. Pang is an Associate Professor of veterinary anesthesiology at the University of Calgary's Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (UCVM). He received his veterinary degree in 2000 from the University of Bristol and completed a MSc and residency in veterinary anesthesia at the *Université de Montréal* after a year in small animal practice and an internship (University of Glasgow). He received his doctorate in neuroscience (molecular mechanisms of volatile anaesthetics) from Imperial College, London in 2011. Dr. Pang teaches anesthesia at UCVM, where he has supervised numerous undergraduate and graduate students. His research interests include pain assessment (pain scale development and validation, including grimace scales), perioperative safety (checklists and M&M rounds) and improving clinical practice (clinical audit). Through UCVM's Distributed Veterinary Learning Community, Dr. Pang frequently provides advice and support to local veterinary practitioners.
