After 15 years of general practice, Dr. Wilson began her residency training with the American College of Veterinary Behaviorists and has been specializing in small animal behaviour cases for over 10 years. Dr. Wilson is one of only 10 Animal Behaviour Specialist in Canada. She is a member of the American Veterinary Society of Animal Behavior, an official member of the Fear Free Speakers Bureau and is Elite Fear Free certified. Dr. Wilson is the first behaviourist to publish research findings on cat scratching substrate preferences in a peer-reviewed journal.
